Audry Funk is a rapper, singer, songwriter, and educator originally from Puebla, Mexico, and currently based in the Bronx, New York. With more than twenty years in the independent scene, she has established herself as one of the most powerful voices in Latin hip hop, blending rap, reggae, cumbia, and Afro-Latin rhythms with messages of resistance, healing, and social justice. Her style combines deep lyricism, a philosophy rooted in migration, and a distinctive flow that resonates with transnational audiences.

As an independent artist, Audry has performed across Latin America, the United States, and Europe, standing out for her collaborative and community driven work. Her music engages with processes of emancipation, grassroots feminisms, and the migrant experience, while also integrating her pedagogical work into educational and cultural projects.
